The track was pretty dirty at the start of Race 2 so it was all about adapting and I was focused on managing my tyres and fighting up the grid for the rest of the race. We'll take the key learnings from this weekend and start prepping for the next round in Zandvoort."

It feels amazing to achieve my first podium of the season, and my first in Red Bull Racing Pepe Jeans Academy Programme colours, while also securing some good points for the team with a double points finish. Overall, it was a great weekend in Barcelona and it's only upwards from here!"
